Regulations

1. The total credits required for graduation are 32 credits (comprising 18 required credits, 14 elective credits, and 6 thesis credits).
2. Credits per semester: First-year students may register for 6–16 credits in their first semester; all other semesters allow 3–16 credits.
3. Students must either complete the academic ethics course offered by the Taiwan Academic Ethics Education Resources Center and obtain a certificate of completion, or attend at least 6 hours of academic ethics-related workshops and obtain a certificate of participation. When applying for the master's thesis oral examination, students must submit one of the aforementioned certificates; only upon review and approval may the application for the oral examination proceed.
4. Students may take courses required for their research from master's programs in other departments within the university. Credits earned and approved by the department may be recognized as elective credits for this master's program, up to a maximum of 3 credits. Students may also take courses from graduate schools at other universities that are not offered by this master's program; however, only one course up to 3 credits may be recognized, and such credits will be included in the calculation of elective credits taken from other departments' master's programs.
5. Students admitted to the master's program under Article 7 of the "Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission" shall receive course consultation and academic guidance arranged by the department. These courses and guidance hours will not be counted toward graduation credits.
